

Race Events

- 3 race series of our own
 - May 29th, July 17th, and September 11th
- Open Practice on April 23rd
 - \$5 for each rider
 - Need EMT or spectator insurance

Track Changes

- Potential track changes were discussed again
 - Getting rid of single file to finish line and adding rhythm sections
 - Make more sweeping corners; less choppy
- Need to create more riding areas
 - Making clearer riding paths for more beginner riders
- Pee Track changes
 - Make it way more challenging, ex. (whoops, jumps)
 - Groom with box blade
- Getting track to hold moisture & direct water flow
 - Figure out how to design the track around where water naturally flows so we don't get huge cracks in the track
 - Hydro seeding and adding grass to keep moisture in

Miscellaneous Topics

- There will be 4 or 5 members on the Track Committee
 - Bobby Shepherd and Doug Horrocks volunteered to take on a position
 - This Track Committee will rotate shifts between being responsible for which members are working on certain work days
 - Other Committee members will be rounded up at the next meeting
- Work days will be the first and third Wednesday nights of each month
 - Duties will be delegated at the monthly meeting
- Membership changes are as follows

- **A single working membership is \$60 with 5 hours of track work and a single non-working membership is \$110**
- **A family working membership is \$100 with 10 hours of track work and a family non-working membership is \$150**
- Members have the whole year to get their track hours in
- Members who buy a working membership will have to check in with a Committee member on a Wednesday work day or contact a board member for more information on when they can get their hours in
- Members who buy a working membership and fail to complete track work will be charged the extra \$50 when purchasing the next year's membership
- Working members will have their hours recorded publicly on the Powder Basin Mx website under the Members section
- Before the April 23rd Open Practice members will be trained on how to run and **take care** of the equipment and also how to properly groom the track
 - Details of this training session will be decided at the April 5th meeting
- Day Passes were discussed
 - \$10 a day and can only be purchased at Destination X or any other store willing to handle day passes
 - A deposit of \$50 will be taken and after 48 hours of the key not being returned the deposit will turn into a single working membership
- Sponsor Committee

- Secretary will have the following duties this month

 - Check when Graduation is this year and any conflicting dates with Cam-Plex
